

(Make your social profiles professional & consistent)

— 12 new kickers in 2022 / Practice squad makes \$11,500/wk. / 1,700 players: 1600 DI, 70 DII & 30 DIII

8 USFL teams: 8 kickers & punters (\$74K max / \$400 housing stipend)

8 XFL teams: 8 kickers & punters (\$72K max / \$60K avg.)

AFL (Arena) 16 teams: 16 kickers (\$40K) Shut down in 2019, scheduled to return in 2024
